Summary:

The health and wellbeing of our customers and team members is paramount to the operation of The Piano Bar Soho and Club 16.

This document assesses the risk of transmission of COVID-19 to team members and customers within our public areas and back of house areas, including the kitchens and office space, and outlines the controls in place to prevent the spread of the virus.

This document has been written in line with government and industry guidance and the controls identified will be reviewed and updated as required. Team member and customer feedback is important to us and this will also feed into any future revisions.

This document will be made available to the public on our website and with team members during their return to work conversations with line management.

Complimentary PPE (Masks and Gloves) will be available to all hosts/musicians when they are working in customer facing areas, face coverings must be worn for hosts during service interaction. Maximum capacities of back of house areas are one person at any one time. Self-isolation will be insisted upon for any host or performer who has a confirmed case of COVID-19, or displaying any of the recognised symptoms or living with anyone who is displaying any of the symptoms. We have introduced floor markings and signage in all the back of house areas to support social distancing. Antibacterial wipes to be used for all Hosts & Performers Equipment. If hosts/musicians travel abroad will be required to self-isolate for 14 days upon returning to the UK. All hosts/musicians will be required to maintain social distancing with each other during working hours whenever possible. Enhanced cleaning programme throughout the venue, back of house areas and office spaces is in place.	

Ventilation Improvements

Where it is only possible for guests to be 1M+ apart, risk mitigation practices are in place including an upgrade to our Air Conditioning system (separate zones rather than central).

All windows in the venue that can open will be opened.

The installation of medical grade Air Purifiers. The VitaShield IPS with NanoProtect Filter boosts clean air delivery to 393 m3/hr, effectively removing particles, allergens, bacteria and viruses including the Coronavirus airborne particle.

Performance Restrictions

As part of our COVID-19 Risk Assessment additional measures are in place around our performers. Where Wind/Horn/Vocal performers cannot be 2M apart screens have been installed around their performance area. The performance area is only for two performers maximum, a third performer can accompany them for no more than 15 minutes at a time.

NHS Test and Trace in operation

Every guest must hold a valid ticket to enter the venue (no exceptions). At the point of purchase test and trace information is collected and stored against their check-in status by management. We encourage you to also "Check-In" using the NHS Test and Trace App.
